Application of Chas. E. Wilson No. 5836

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in ON PAROLE
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11 th day of May
A. D. 1933, at Richfield, County of Sevier
and State of Utah, in Sixth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable N. J. Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable H. E. Beale prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Charles Edward Wilson
I was convicted under the name of Charles Edward Wilson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Once on a similar
charge in 1930. But both of these convictions were for the same
offense which was committed in 1930. I was sentenced then on a
check of \$4.50 and again in 1932 on a check of about the same
amount which was written and cashed at the same time the \$4.50
one was in February 1930. I have been straight since and intend
to continue so too.
