First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Perjury

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of January
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge D. W. Mapp presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence
from one to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Calvin Richards prosecuted the case.
