To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~Parole~~ Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Penitentiary
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of extortion.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of October
A. D. 1928, at Price County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to indeterminate term, not to exceed three
years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary.

Fourth-Honorable Fred Keller, District Attorney, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Rose Prince
