I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of extortion

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of January  
A. D. 1930, at Price County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in 7<sup>th</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to indeterminate  
(one to three years)  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable F. W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Rosa Prince  
I was convicted under the name of Rosa Prince
