Application of Elmer Winger

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Penitentiary
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of November
A. D. 30, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Roger I. McDonough presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from five years to
Life in the State Penitentiary
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary.

Fourth-- Honorable Calvin W. Rawlings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Elmer Winger.

I was convicted under the name of Elmer Winger.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Thomas Lock.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none.
