First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in On Parole  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of March  
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Summit  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McKinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to ten years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
Paroled April 22, 1931

Fourth-Honorable Ray VanCott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Rudolph Kooyman  
I was convicted under the name of Rudolph Kooyman
