First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in On Parole
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of March
A. D. 1930, at Coalville County of Summit
and State of Utah, in Coalville Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge James H. Mc Kinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 10 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
14 months on parole sent

Fourth-Honorable Ray Vaneet prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Rudolph Koryman

I was convicted under the name of Rudolph Koryman
