First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in ON PAROLE
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of March
A. D. 1935, at Coalville County of Summit
and State of Utah, in Summit Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James W. Mc Kinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to ten years in the State
prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison for
eighteen months
