and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 24th of December  
A. D. 1929, at Provo County of Utah  
and State of Utah, in District Court Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Worthem presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to six months to three years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison,  
Salt Lake City, Utah,

Fourth-Honorable District Attorney G. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Orval McCracken  
I was convicted under the name of Orval Mc Cracken
