Application of Frank J. Wallat No. 5350

and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Car Theft

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of February
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge David W. Moffat presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An Indeterminate sentence of from ninety
days to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
