and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of October
A. D. 1930, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Mr. Wilson prosecuted the case.
