To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION OF SENTENCE
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in THE UTAH STATE PRISON
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of ASSAULT TO MURDER

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of April
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in THE THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable McCONKIE presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to AN INDETERMINATE TERM
and thereafter was imprisoned in the UTAH STATE PRISON

Fourth-Honorable B. L. RICE prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is STANLEY HUDSON
I was convicted under the name of STANLEY HUDSON
