Application of Raymond M. Underwood No. 5367

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination to leave state and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd degree.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9 day of April A. D. 1930 at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in 4th district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable _____ presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six months to three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison at Salt Lake City.

Fourth-Honorable M. O. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Marvin P. Underwood I was convicted under the name of Raymond M. Underwood.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Frank Phillips.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary 1st & 2nd 1924, at Montgomery, Missouri, served 4 years 4 months 4 days.
