under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of April  
A. D. 1932, at Provo, County of Utah  
and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Maurice Harding presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Three year maximum or 6 months  
to 3 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at Salt Lake City

Fourth-Honorable Maurice Harding prosecuted the case.
