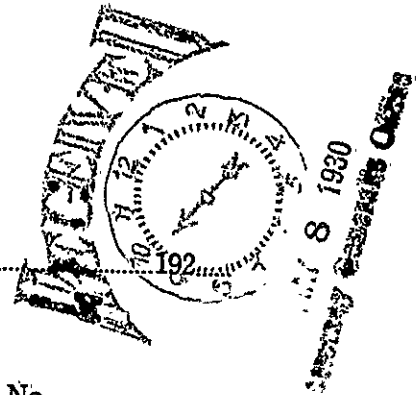

County and lived with my Uncle for ~~for~~ five months, when I returned  
home to Kanab, in the year 1929.
