First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary (third degree)

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August  
A. D. 1932, at Kanab Utah County of Kane  
and State of Utah, in The 6<sup>th</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to The Utah State prison for a  
period not less than 6 months and not more than 3 yrs.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary.
