Application of George E. Young

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of August
A. D. 1932, at Kanab Utah County of Kane
and State of Utah, in The Sixth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to The Utah State Prison for
a period of not less than six months nor more than three years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Henry Beal prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is George E. Young
I was convicted under the name of George E. Young

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Mr. Richard Jackson

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary
in the third degree but I did not do any
time in a prison. I was paroled to the
Sheriff of Kane County. This happened about
three years ago.
