Application of Termination No. 5880

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in on parole  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of third degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August  
A. D. 1932, at Kanab Utah County of Kane  
and State of Utah, in Sixth District Court Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to not more than six months and not more  
than three years in Utah State Prison  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison for nine  
months and

Fourth-Honorable Henry Wells prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is George Edwin Young  
I was convicted under the name of George Young

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Arland Jackson who was put on  
probation two days. I have been on parole since May 20<sup>th</sup>

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.  
I have been arrested once before.
