Application of Termination No. 0880

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in parole from U.S.P.
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of third degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16 day of August
A. D. 1932, at Kanab Utah County of Kane
and State of Utah, in sixth district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to the U.S.P. for a period not less than
six months and not more than three years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison for nine
months there was released on parole

Fourth-Honorable Attorney Riels prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is George Elmer Young
I was convicted under the name of George Young

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Orland Jackson - who was put on probation
he was a juvenile.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except one misdemeanor
"Smoking" and being drunk in public place.
and once a felony which I received a sentence
to the U.S.P. and did not go on account of
a petition from the people of Kanab, Utah.
But was paroled by the Board of pardons.
