First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison On Parole  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March  
A. D. 1930, at Kingston County of Piute  
and State of Utah, in Sixth Judicial District Court Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Term of One to 5 yrs.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Olof R. Michelsen prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William L. Nay.  
I was convicted under the name of William L. Nay.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except  
County Jail sentence just before I was sent to  
State Prison.
