I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of First Degree Burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25 day of May
A. D. 1929, at Manti County of Sanpete
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State-aforesaid, Honorable Judge W. Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 25 to 40 Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Fred Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Fred Henry Wagner.

I was convicted under the name of Fred H. Bauer.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: John Ryan, and one other person unknown to me.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except As shown on record.
