Application of Melvin E. Lewis No. 5153.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows: on Parole

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of March
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in The Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one indeterminate term
of one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Melvin E. Lewis

I was convicted under the name of Melvin E. Lewis
