and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 1st Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of May
A. D. 1929, at Manti County of San Pete
and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 25 to 40 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable F. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is F.H. Bauer
I was convicted under the name of F.H. Bauer

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: F.H. Wagner, John Ryan.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except
As records show.

I am not asking any mercy or justice, only for my right.
please tell the Warden to open the gate. I promise to go
straight. I did not commit the crime any more than you did.
