Application of Fred H. Bauer

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 1st Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of May,
A. D. 1929, at County of San Pete
and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Wooley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Fred Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Fred H. Wagner

I was convicted under the name of Fred H. Bauer

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Frank Anderson and John Ryan.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except that shown by records.
