under conviction and a sentence on a charge of First Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of May
A. D. 1929, at Manti County of San Pete
and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Woolly presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 25 to 40 Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable District Attorney Keller prosecuted the case.
