Application of Will Anderson No. 5375

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of third degree burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22 day of April A. D. 1930, at Moab County of Grand and State of Utah, in Court, in and for the

County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wooley presiding. Third-I was sentenced to six months to three years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable J. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Will Anderson

I was convicted under the name of Will Anderson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none
