I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Rape

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of February
A. D. 1930, at Richfield County of Sevier
and State of Utah, in the Sixth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable N. J. Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term of from One to Ten
years in the Utah State Penitentiary
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth-Honorable T. A. Hunt prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Alma Earl Borg

I was convicted under the name of Earl Borg
