Application of Frank Leonard No. 5346

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Highway Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of February
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable D. W. Moffatt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Not less than 5 years or
more than 20
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Frank William Leonard
I was convicted under the name of Frank Allen

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Ray O'Connor

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except
Oregon State Training School
