A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake,  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge D.W.Moffatt, presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 5 to 20 years,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.
