Application of Ferris Murphy

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Depriving the Owner the Use of His Car.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of November  
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 90 Days To Ten Years.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Calvin Rollins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Ferris Earl Workman.  
I was convicted under the name of Ferris Murphy.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: LeRoy Thomas, Harry Chamberlin.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except As Record Shows.
