Application of Ferris Murphy No. 5819

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination & re-instated and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16 day of April A. D. 1932, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable David W Moffat presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Allen G Thurman prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Earl Ferris X Workman

I was convicted under the name of Ferris Murphy

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Brian E Beddo

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Depriving the owner the use of his car.
