I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July  
A. D. 1930, at Logan County of Cache  
and State of Utah, in First District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Ten Years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable George Preston prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is George Robert Shields

I was convicted under the name of George R. Shields

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except above
