and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in UTAH STATE PRISON
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of FORGERY

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the DEC 20 day of 1929
1930

A. D. SALT LAKE County of SALT LAKE
and State of Utah, in FOURTH DISTRICT Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable JUDGE MOFFET presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to ONE TO TWENTY YEARS

and thereafter was imprisoned in the UTAH STATE PRISON

Fourth--Honorable RAY VAN COT prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is MILLWARD ANDREW

I was convicted under the name of MILLWARD ANDREW

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: NONE

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except ONLY AS SHOWN ON
RECORD I WOULD LIKE TO BE TERMINATED TO MY SISTER IN KANSAS CITY MO.
AND WORK FOR HER. I WILL NOT COME BACK TO THIS STATE AND WILL GO STRAIGHT
I WILL HAVE A SOME MONEY TO GO THERE WITH. I WILL BE A WAY FROM MY BAD
COMPANY AND WILL HAVE A OPPORTUNITY OF MY LIFE AND IT MAY BE MY LAST
MY SISTER WILL WRITE A LETTER TO YOU THE BOARD MEMBERS.
