under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 1st Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of Sept.,
A. D. 1929, at Farmington, Utah County of Davis
and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable David Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Harry A. Gravell
I was convicted under the name of H.A. Gravell

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: John Segdie

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Robbery.
