First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of June
A. D. 1931, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Eugene E. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Chester Brown

I was convicted under the name of Chester Brown

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Leslie Brown

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows
