Application of Carl Low Terry No. 5319

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows: To Portola Calif. Home Transportation

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of January
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge S. W. Maffat presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence
from one to Twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
