To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of March
A. D. 1929, at Ogden Utah County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five years to Life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Herbert Stern

I was convicted under the name of George Howard

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Elmer Wilcox ⁵¹⁶⁴ Terminated By Board of Pardons
September 1930

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except As Record Shows
