First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December A. D. 1929, at Ogden County of Weber

and State of Utah, in second judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. M. S. Parker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to thirty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Leslie Grant Heit

I was convicted under the name of Leslie Heit

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Wm. Van Der Wijk, Leonard Gibson, Geo. Robert Peterson

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except State Industrial School
