I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the County Jail of Salt Lake
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of involuntary manslaughter

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd. day of November
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in The Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve six (6) months
and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail of Salt Lake County

Fourth-Honorable Calvin W. Rawlins prosecuted the case.
