Application of Will Burt Updike No. 5133

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Rape

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of February
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Oscar McConkle presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An indeterminate sentence of five
five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Dist. Att. Rice prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Will Burt Updike
I was convicted under the name of Will Burt Updike
