and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Rape

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9 day of February
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake Co County of 3rd Dist
and State of Utah, in 3 Dist court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McConkey presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to indefinite sentence
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Dist Attorney Rice prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Willbert Updyke
I was convicted under the name of Willbert Updyke

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: C. C. Valand, Lewis Monroe

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as found

C. C. Valand Terminated nearly a year ago
Lewis Monroe died from old age
something like 6 months ago
I am here and don't know why
