I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination to go to California
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny Car Theft

Second-I was convicted Plead Guilty and sentenced on the 17 day of October

A. D. 1929, at Parowan County of Iron

and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the

County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Leroy Cox presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 10 yrs.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Atty. Shay prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John Cabrerias

I was convicted under the name of

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Frank Leaman James Kortagan

Albert De Lorgis

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except shown on record
Remarks. The Sheriff J. C. Leigh told us he
didn't want to send four men to prison for
this crime. If one of us plead guilty he would
release the other three. We drew straws as to who
would plead guilty. I was elected and so plead guilty.
