Application of Thomas Edward Jones No. 5333

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah On Parole
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of February
A. D. 1930, at Provo County of Utah
and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George W. Worthen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison Feb
5th 1930 and was Paroled to
O. W. Melcher June 24th 1930

Fourth-Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Thomas Edward Jones

I was convicted under the name of Same
