First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in On Parole
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of Feb.
A. D. 1930, at Provo County of Utah
and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. W. Worther presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate term of
One to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
Feb. 5th 1930. (Paroled June 24th
1930)

Fourth-Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Thomas Edward Jones

I was convicted under the name of Same
