Application of William Arthur Johnson No. 5294

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of December  
A. D. 1929, at Duchesne County of Duchesne  
and State of Utah, in The Fourth District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. H. Hooten presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six Months to Three years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Arthur Johnson  
I was convicted under the name of Arthur Johnson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Richard Johnson

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except what are on record
