County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Cox, presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Utah State Prison, State Of Utah,  
For An indeterminate sentence of One to twenty years,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison, State Of Utah,  
With A recommendation of a few months, By the Honorable Judge Cox.

Fourth-Honorable prosecuted the case.
