First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of January
A. D. 1921, at Fillmore Utah County of Millard
and State of Utah, in Fifth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Leroy S. Cox presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable L. Larson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Byrum Lindsay
I was convicted under the name of Byrum Lindsay
