To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of September A. D. 1928, at Brigham City County of Bozeman and State of Utah, in County Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of Five (5) years to Life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Le Roy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Albert Barajas.

I was convicted under the name of Sciner.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: S. Cardenas and V. Alvarez.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except murder.

I ask for Conditional Pardon to leave the state.
