Application of Rollen Harkey No. 5265

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree Burglery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of October
A. D. 1929, at Ogden Utah County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 6 Mo. to 3 yrs.
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Rollen Harkey
I was convicted under the name of Rollen Harkey.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
