Application of Scott Buncie No. 6186

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a **TERMINATION** and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of May A. D. 1934 at Coalville County of Summit and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Roger T. McDonough presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Calvin W. Rowlin prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Scott Buncie

I was convicted under the name of Scott Buncie

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows
